Resolution in Support of CWA 9415 Workers at KPFA

On Monday, October 25, 2010, this resolution was passed unanimously by the Delegate Body of the San Francisco Labor Council:

By unanimous vote, the delegates of the San Francisco Labor Council condemn the efforts by the Pacifica National Board in its blatant anti-union actions, including but not limited to:

1. Violating the Pacifica National Board bylaws by getting involved in personnel matters, including making individual name recommendations for layoffs as a way to resolve the budget crisis at KPFA.
2. Illegally violating the standing collective bargaining agreement/union contract between CWA Local 415, the interim KPFA General Manager and the Executive Director of the Pacifica Foundation.

CWA 9415, the union representing the KPFA workers, is working with the Alameda CLC on the next actions to be taken. The San Francisco Labor Council will take appropriate steps to support CWA 9415 and the Alameda CLC when notified.
